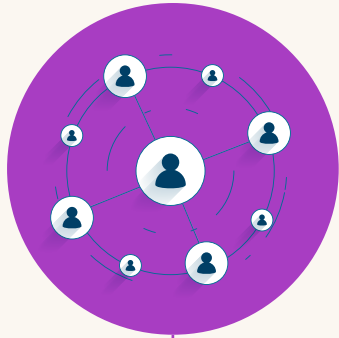
About Eurocham

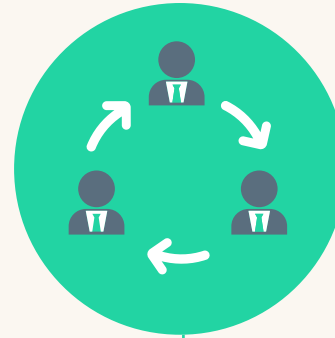
Our mission is clear: to foster trade, drive investment, and promote sustainable growth while creating a favorable and enabling business environment for our members to thrive.

Working Groups

- **SME Members:** Annual turnover between N100 million - N500 million

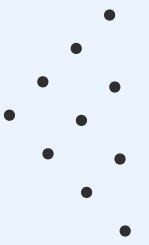


ASSOCIATE MEMBERS
